Updated March 2021

All applicants for an immigrant visa (also known as a green card) must show proof of having received these vaccines (or having immunity to the disease), unless the vaccine is not medically appropriate.

- Diphtheria
- Tetanus
- Pertussis
- Polio
- Measles
- Mumps
- Rubella
- *Haemophilus influenzae* type b (Hib)
- Hepatitis B
- Varicella (chicken pox)
- Pneumococcal disease
- Influenza (seasonal)
- Rotavirus
- Hepatitis A
- Meningococcal disease
